HIV Edmonton wants to thank Daltyn for all the help he has provided this past year and we look forward in working with him in the new year.

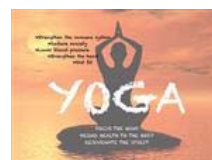
Christmas Cookies
