



Volunteer Job Description

Route Marshals

Summary/Purpose:

Patrol route maintaining order of walkers, set up and tear down route decorations.

Authority / Accountability:

City Police, Emergency Medical Technicians, Volunteer Coordinator, Decorating Lead

Tasks / Responsibility:

- ROUTE: decorate the route (put up signs on stakes, ribbons on poles)
- Cheer on walkers throughout the walk.
- Adhere to the direction of the City Police.
- Remove decorations along the route (take down signs on stakes, ribbons on poles)
- Report to Volunteer Coordinator at the start and end of each volunteer shift.

Knowledge, Skills and Attitudes

Skills:

Verbal and listening skills, long periods of standing and walking, dexterous, work well with others, eye for detail, heavy lifting. Volunteers will be oriented at the start of shift.
